Hayhurst's credentials include a number of teaching positions including part-time instructor and evaluator for the National Tooling and Machining Association's machinist apprenticeship training and tool and cutter grinding instructor at NASA's Lewis Research Center (now Glenn Research Center) in Cleveland.

Locally he worked as a tool and die maker at Dyna-Craft Inc., division of National Semiconductor Corp., Murrysville, and as a tool and cutter grinder at Custom Tool and Grinding, Washington, PA.

Hayhurst is an alumnus of the University of Pittsburgh, earning a Bachelor of Science degree in computer science and a Master of Science degree in industrial engineering.
