In Westmoreland County, there are five machinist jobs available for every one applicant. Most don't require a college degree, just work-related, on-the-job training. The average Machinist I salary in Pennsylvania is \$47,050, with a range typically between \$41,837 and \$53,607. (Salary.com, 2023)

- Successful performance on an industry-developed aptitude test (tutoring available)
