What is M2K?

The M2K Program, offered on Pittsburgh's South Side and at Eastern Westmoreland Career & Technology Center (EWCTC) in Latrobe, provides 3 levels of training up to 600 hours. These sessions include hands-on experience, as well as special sessions focused on professional development and resume writing.

Three Levels of Training available:

Level 1 - Manual Machine Operator Trainee

Level 2 - Manual Machine Operator/Machinist Trainee

Level 3 - Manual/CNC Machinist Trainee

What will I learn?

M2K students learn the basics of operating:

- Lathes
- Vertical Milling Machines
- CNC Machines
- Pedestal Grinders
- Saws
- Drill Presses
- Surface Grinders
- Various Shop Tools

What are the class options?

Pittsburgh: 9:00 A.M. - 3:00 P.M., Mon. - Fri. Latrobe: 4:00 P.M. - 9:00 P.M., Mon. - Fri.

How much does it cost?

Training is made possible through a variety of governmental or charitable funding sources, as well as manufacturing employer contributions. There is no cost to qualified students who are accepted into the program.

How do I register?

Registration is offered on an on going basis throughout the year. Contact New Century Careers to schedule a tour or to receive an application packet.

New Century Careers administers enrollment for all sites (Pittsburgh and Latrobe). Start dates may be subject to change depending on enrollment.

Applicants must:

- Be at least 18 years of age
- Have earned a High School Diploma or GED*
- Submit a completed application packet, including High School Diploma/GED, two reference letters, a brief questionnaire, and an application form
- Demonstrate successful performance on an industry-developed aptitude test

Why manufacturing?

Manufacturing is the second-largest source of private sector employment in southwestern PA. Manufacturing accounts for 15% of regional employment.

The average annual wage for machinists in PA is \$50,420**. The vast majority of these jobs do not require a college degree. Instead, most manufacturing jobs require work-related and on-the-job training.

MANUFACTURING 2000 Application Process and Training Agreement

The application process consists of four steps. You will need to complete all four steps to be considered for the MANUFACTURING 2000 training program. However, completing an application does not guarantee a spot in our program, as space is limited.

The four steps of the application process are:

- 1. Complete the Application Packet (attached).
- 2. Submit Two Letters of Recommendation
 - Letters can be from anyone except a family member
 - Forged letters will disqualify you from the program
- 3. Submit Your High School Diploma or GED or Transcripts
 - Photocopies may be submitted—certified transcripts are not necessary
- 4. Take the Aptitude Test- CONTACT US AT info@ncsquared.com TO SCHEDULE YOUR TEST TODAY! TESTS CAN BE SCHEDULED AT OUR PITTSBURGH SITE OR LATROBE SITE. NOTE: TEST CANNOT BE TAKEN UNTIL STEPS 1-3 ARE COMPLETED & TURNED IN
 - Please contact us to schedule your test.
 - The test will last approximately 1.5 to 3 hours and will consist of 4 parts:
 - Mechanical Reasoning
 - Problem Solving
 - Vocabulary
 - Math (Fractions & decimals, basic algebra, geometry and trig at a high school level)
